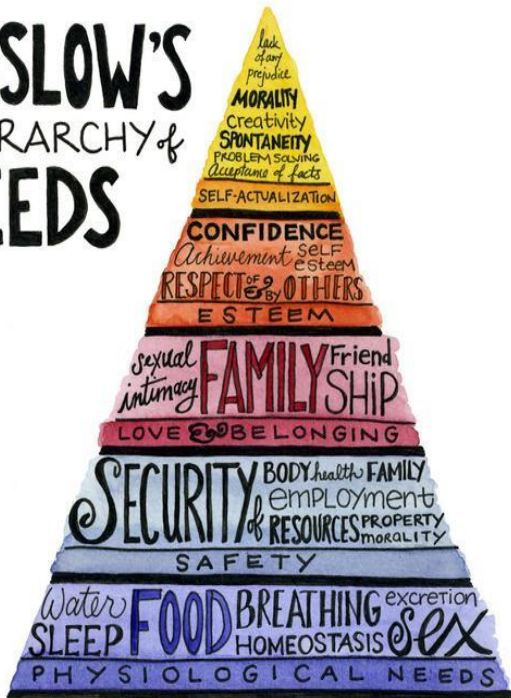

What is Targeted Case Management (TCM)?

Working one-on-one with a Targeted Case Manager who will help you identify your needs, develop goals, and work towards achieving those goals.

Who is Eligible for TCM?

Medicaid recipients who are seeing a Behavioral Health Provider and have a current qualifying diagnosis of a Severe Mental Illness (SMI), Severe Emotional Disorder (SED- under 18 years of age), Substance Use Disorder (SUD), or a Co-Occurring Behavioral Health and Chronic or Complex Physical Health Condition (CCPHC).

What a TCM Can Help with:

Basic Needs: Provide housing applications, provide information on income based/low income housing options, applying for government assistance, food stamps/WIC benefits, food boxes, applying for Social security/disability benefits, childcare assistance, etc.

Medical Needs: Finding a PCP/specialist, scheduling medical appts, identifying resources for costs of prescription medication.

Employment Resources: Resume writing, providing resources for available jobs to apply for, preparing for an interview, acquiring appropriate clothing for job.

Educational Needs: Want to get your GED, further your education with college, or have a child struggling to meet goals within school and need intervention/communication assistance with school.

Additional Needs: Support, advocacy, accountability, educational opportunities, budgeting, Medicaid transportation, recreational/socialization skills etc.

We work with social service organizations to gather and provide resources to clients. Services offered will be dependent on the needs of the client.
